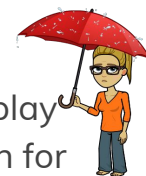

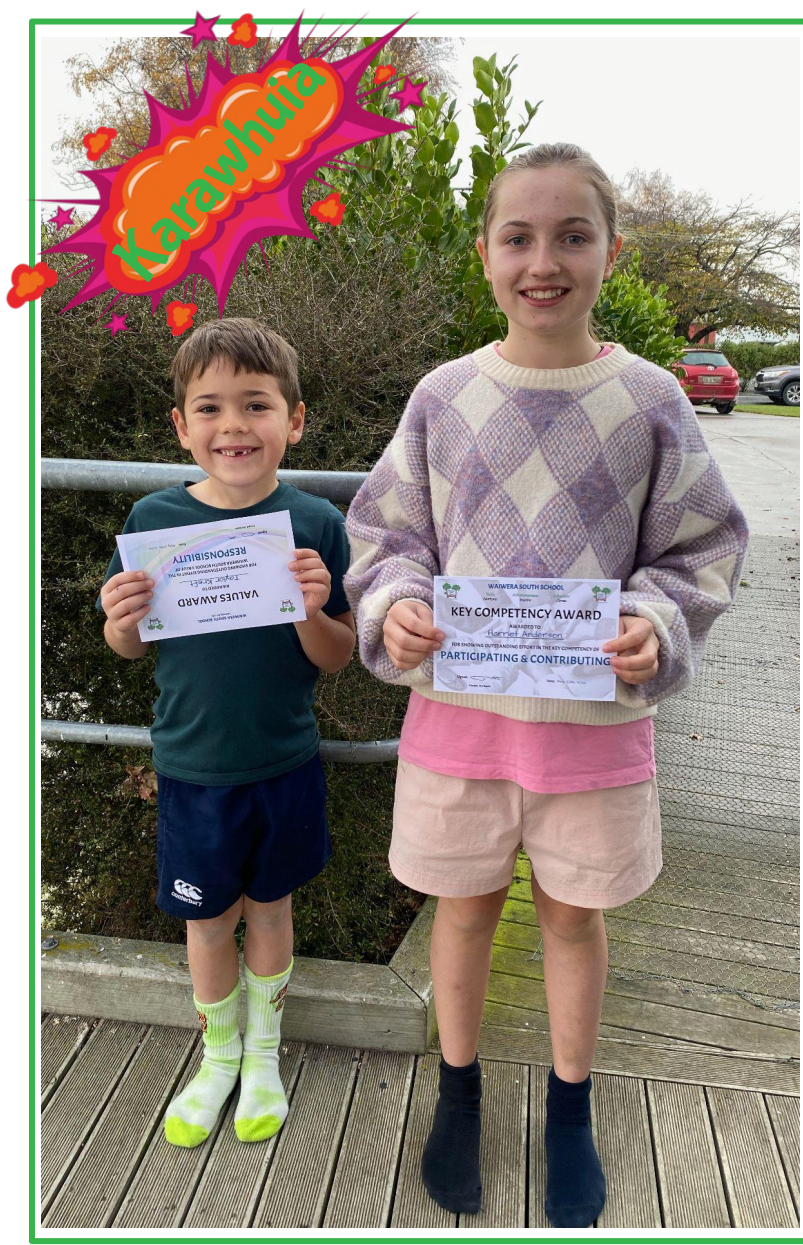

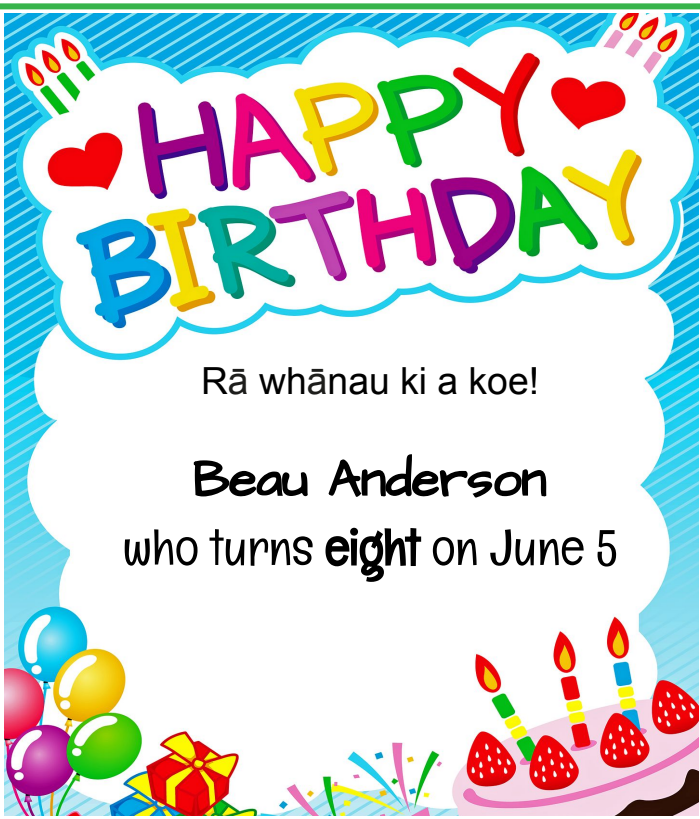
JUNIOR CLASS MOUNTAIN BIKING
